




Weekly case rate and rate of change per 100,000 population by Local










- The chart shows weekly case rates by area as on 11 May 2021 compared to weekly case rates by area as on 04 May.
- The vertical axis plots the most recent weekly case rate per 100k people (up to the 11 May), and the horizontal axis plots the equivalent case rate from the week before. The higher the bubble, the worse the current case rate picture.
- The size of each bubble is proportional to the most recent case rate per 100k people in those aged over 60 years.
- The colour of each bubble indicates which region the area is in.






North West regional case numbers, testing numbers and positivity, 01 Oct to 16 May 2021




DAILY NUMBERS OF COVID-19 PATIENTS ADMITTED TO HOSPITAL

DAILY COUNT OF CONFIRMED COVID-19 PATIENTS IN HOSPITAL AT 8AM


















Yorkshire and Humber regional case numbers, testing numbers and positivity, 01 Oct to 16 May 2021





DAILY COUNT OF CONFIRMED COVID-19 PATIENTS IN HOSPITAL AT 8AM





Regional age-stratified case rate heatmap for West Midlands: 19 Apr to 16 May 2021,










DAILY NUMBERS OF COVID-19 PATIENTS ADMITTED TO HOSPITAL

DAILY COUNT OF CONFIRMED COVID-19 PATIENTS IN HOSPITAL AT 8AM





Regional age-stratified case rate heatmap for East of England: 19 Apr to 16 May 2021,










