




### South East age-stratified heatmap of weekly case rate, 26 Apr to 19 May 2021











#### Age-stratified case rate heatmap for Hart: 26 Apr to 23 May 2021









#### Age-stratified case rate heatmap for Lewes: 26 Apr to 23 May 2021






#### Age-stratified case rate heatmap for Swale: 26 Apr to 23 May 2021




