





Yorkshire and Humber age-stratified heatmap of weekly case rate, 26 Apr to 19 May 2021









Yorkshire and Humber age-stratified heatmap of weekly case rate by local authority, 26 Apr to 19 May 2021














Bradford case numbers, testing numbers and positivity, 1 Oct to 23 May 2021










Calderdale case numbers, testing numbers and positivity, 1 Oct to 23 May 2021










Craven case numbers, testing numbers and positivity, 1 Oct to 23 May 2021



















East Riding of Yorkshire case numbers, testing numbers and positivity, 1 Oct to 23 May 2021



















Harrogate case numbers, testing numbers and positivity, 1 Oct to 23 May 2021









Kingston upon Hull, City of case numbers, testing numbers and positivity, 1 Oct to 23 May 2021





Age-stratified case rate heatmap for Kingston upon Hull, City of: 26 Apr to 23 May 2021











Leeds case numbers, testing numbers and positivity, 1 Oct to 23 May 2021




Age-stratified case rate heatmap for Leeds: 26 Apr to 23 May 2021














Rotherham case numbers, testing numbers and positivity, 1 Oct to 23 May 2021















Age-stratified case rate heatmap for Selby: 26 Apr to 23 May 2021














Wakefield case numbers, testing numbers and positivity, 1 Oct to 23 May 2021








York case numbers, testing numbers and positivity, 1 Oct to 23 May 2021
