During the period 2019 to date, MHRA has become aware of 15,238 units of falsified medicines in the UK.

A falsified medicine is any medicinal product with a false misrepresentation of its history, source or identity. Although a falsified medicine cannot be guaranteed to meet standards of safety, quality or efficacy, it does not automatically pose a risk to patient health.
