- 3. The claimant's claim for breach of contract is allowed. The respondent was in breach of contract by dismissing the claimant without notice.
- 4. The respondent is ordered to pay the claimant the sum of £375 gross, being damages for the breach of contract.
- 5. The respondent is also ordered to pay the claimant the sum of £150 for 2 days accrued but untaken leave as at the date of termination.
