JUDGMENT

- 1. The claim of unauthorised deduction from wages is struck out because the Claimant has failed to pay a deposit in relation to that claim by the due date.
- 2. The claim for notice pay is struck out because it has not been actively pursued.
- 3. The Hearing on 9 June 2021 is cancelled.

REASONS

- 1. By an Order dated 16 March 2021 the Claimant was ordered to pay a deposit of £20 by 30 March 2021 as a pre-condition of being able to pursue his claim of unauthorised deductions from wages. He failed to pay that deposit. His claim is therefore struck out under Rule 39(4) of the Tribunal's Rules of Procedure.
- 2. By a letter dated **29 April 2021** the Tribunal gave the claimant an opportunity to make representations or to request a hearing, as to why his claim for notice pay should not be struck out because it was not being actively pursued. The Claimant has not responded to that letter. The claim is therefore struck out under 37(1)(d) of the Tribunal's Rules of Procedure.
