## **JUDGMENT**

- 1. The claimant was unfairly dismissed by the respondent.
- 2. The claimant was culpable of action which contributed to the dismissal and, having regard to that conduct, it is just and equitable to reduce the compensatory award by 50%.
- 3. The same conduct, which arose before the dismissal was such that it is just and equitable to reduce the basic award by 50%.
- 4. The claim that the dismissal of the claimant was direct race discrimination has not been established and is dismissed.
- 5. The respondent shall pay to the claimant the agreed sums of £807 in respect of the basic award and £10,000 in respect of the compensatory award, such sums having accounted for the above adjustments.

6. The recoupment provisions do not apply.
