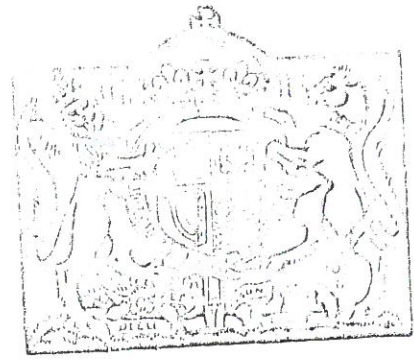

CHAPTER LXXIII.

An Act to confirm certain Provisional Orders A.D. 1925.
made by the Minister of Transport under
the General Pier and Harbour Act 1861
relating to Cattlewater Findochty Llanelly and
Port-nan-long. [31st July 1925.]

WHEREAS a Provisional Order made by the Minister
of Transport under the General Pier and Harbour Act 1861 is not of any validity or force whatever until
the confirmation thereof by Act of Parliament: 21 & 25 Vict.
c. 45

And whereas it is expedient that the Provisional
Orders made by the Minister of Transport under the
said Act and set out in the schedule to this Act be
confirmed by Act of Parliament:

En is therefore enacted by the King's most Excellent
Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the Lords
Spiritual and Temporal and Commons in this present
Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same
as follows:—

1. The Orders as set out in the schedule to this
Act shall be and the same are hereby confirmed and
all the provisions thereof in manner and form as they
are set out in the said schedule shall from and after the
passing of this Act have full validity and force. Confirmation of Orders in schedule.

2. This Act may be cited as the Pier and Harbour Orders Confirmation (No. 1) Act 1925. Short title.

SCHEDULE.

CATTEWATER HARBOUR.

Cattewater Harbour. *Provisional Order for amending the Cattewater Harbour Order 1915 and for conferring further powers on the Cattewater Commissioners.*

PRELIMINARY.

- Short title and construction. 1. This Order may be cited as the Cattewater Harbour Order 1925 and shall be read and construed with the Cattewater Harbour Order 1915 (in this Order called "the Order of 1915") as if the Order of 1915 and this Order were one Order.
- Interpretation. 2. In this Order "the Commissioners" means the Cattewater Commissioners as in the Order of 1915.
- Commencement. 3. This Order shall come into operation upon the day when the Act confirming this Order is passed and that day may be referred to as "the commencement of this Order."

FINANCE.

- Finance. 4.—(1) The Commissioners may from time to time borrow with the approval of the Minister of Transport and in addition to the sums which they are authorised to borrow under the Order of 1915 such further moneys as may be required for the purposes of the Order of 1915 and of this Order not exceeding in the whole the further sum of fifty thousand pounds on the security of the rates dues and tolls for the time being authorised.
- (2) The Commissioners notwithstanding anything contained in the Order of 1915 may pay interest at a rate or rates not exceeding six per centum per annum or such higher rate or rates as may from time to time be approved by the Minister of Transport upon any moneys borrowed under the Order of 1915 or under this Order.
- (3) Section 50 (Sinking fund) of the Order of 1915 shall apply in respect of moneys borrowed under this Order but for the purpose of such application instead of the period of forty years or other period therein prescribed the period or periods shall be those which the Minister of Transport may prescribe in relation to any sum or sums respectively borrowed under this Order.

5. The money borrowed under this Order may be applied for the purposes of this Order or of the Order of 1915 for which capital money may properly be applied and not otherwise.

WORKS AND POWERS.

6. The Commissioners may construct and maintain upon any lands purchased by them under the Order of 1915 such approach roads as may be necessary or expedient for the use or development of the north side of the harbour and may also contribute towards the cost of construction and maintenance by the Corporation of Plymouth or other local authority of any road or roads leading to or improving the means of access to the harbour and may join with the said Corporation or other authority in such construction and maintenance as aforesaid.

Works and
powers.

7. All costs charges and expenses of and incidental to the preparing and obtaining of this Order and otherwise incurred in reference thereto (as taxed by the proper officer) shall be paid by the Commissioners.
