**A12 Kelvedon Bypass – average speed cameras**

Thank you for your email of 7 June 2021 requesting information about the average speed cameras on the A12 Kelvedon Bypass, between junctions 17 and 29.

We have now completed our search for the requested information.

There are a total of 18 cameras on the Kelvedon Bypass, nine on each carriageway at eight locations between the East Thorpe junction and the slip road. These are yellow in colour and visible to drivers.

The average speed cameras enforce the national speed limit.
