JUDGMENT

Employment Tribunals Rules of Procedure 2013 – Rule 21

1. There was no response or appearance by the Respondent in this case and the Claimant's claim for unpaid wages and holiday pay succeeds.
2. The Claimant is entitled to payment by the Respondent forthwith a total of **£4790.79** calculated as follows:
 - a. Net loss of wages at a rate of £229.38 per week for 15.25 weeks (1 January - 18 April 2019) amounting to £3506.34;
 - b. 5.6 weeks' untaken and unpaid holiday in the final year of the Claimant's employment amounting to £1284.55.
