

THE EVENTS RESEARCH PROGRAMME DIRECTION – THE 2020 UEFA EUROPEAN FOOTBALL CHAMPIONSHIPS – MATCHES AT WEMBLEY ON 22nd and 26th JUNE 2021

THE HEALTH PROTECTION (CORONAVIRUS, RESTRICTIONS) (STEPS) (ENGLAND) REGULATIONS 2021

The Secretary of State for Digital, Culture, Media and Sport and the Secretary of State for Health and Social Care, in exercise of the powers conferred by regulation 9 of the Health Protection (Coronavirus, Restrictions) (Steps) (England) Regulations 2021 (the ‘Regulations’)¹, make the following Direction for the purposes of a research programme concerned with the provision of an appropriate public health response to the incidence and spread of coronavirus in England.

Before making this Direction, the Secretaries of State have consulted with Professor Jonathan Van-Tam of the Department of Health and Social Care and had regard to any advice given by him.

1. This Direction applies to—
 - a. the following premises—
 - i. Wembley Stadium, London HA9 0WS (‘Wembley Stadium’);
 - ii. the land immediately outside and around Wembley Stadium, including the Olympic Steps, shown bounded externally by the red line on the Map attached at Annex A, but not including Wembley Stadium (‘the surrounding areas’);
 - iii. the three car parks, labelled as “Yellow Parking”, “Red Parking” and “Pink Parking” and shaded in yellow, red and pink respectively on the Map attached at Annex A (‘the Car Parks’);
 - iv. the two bag drops, labelled as “Yellow Bag Drop” and “Red Bag Drop” and shaded in yellow and red respectively on the Map attached at Annex A (‘the Bag Drops’); and
 - b. the following matches taking place at Wembley Stadium as part of the 2020 Union of European Football Associations European Football Championships (together, ‘the EURO 2020 Matches’)—
 - i. the match between Czech Republic and England taking place on Tuesday 22nd June 2021;
 - ii. the Round of 16 match between taking place on Saturday 26th June 2021.
2. This Direction disapplies the following restrictions and requirements in relation to Wembley Stadium for the purposes of the EURO 2020 Matches on 22nd and 26th June 2021—

- a. In relation to the Regulations—
 - i. paragraph 1, Schedule 3 (participation in gatherings);
 - ii. paragraph 7, Schedule 3 (restrictions on service of food and drink for consumption on the premises); and
 - b. In relation to the Health Protection (Coronavirus, Restrictions) (Obligations of Undertakings) (England) Regulations 2020² ('the Obligations Regulations')—
 - i. regulation 1A(2) (restrictions in relation to relevant premises);
 - ii. regulation 2(1) (restrictions in relation to hospitality undertakings)
3. This Direction disapplies the following restrictions and requirements in relation to the surrounding areas for the purposes of the EURO 2020 Matches on 22nd and 26th June 2021—
- a. In relation to the Regulations—
 - i. paragraph 1, Schedule 3 (participation in gatherings); and
 - b. In relation to the Obligations Regulations—
 - i. regulation 1A(2) (restrictions in relation to relevant premises).
4. This Direction disapplies the following restriction in relation to the Car Parks and the Bag Drops for the purposes of the EURO 2020 Matches on 22nd and 26th June 2021—
- a. In relation to the Regulations—
 - i. paragraph 1, Schedule 3 (participation in gatherings).

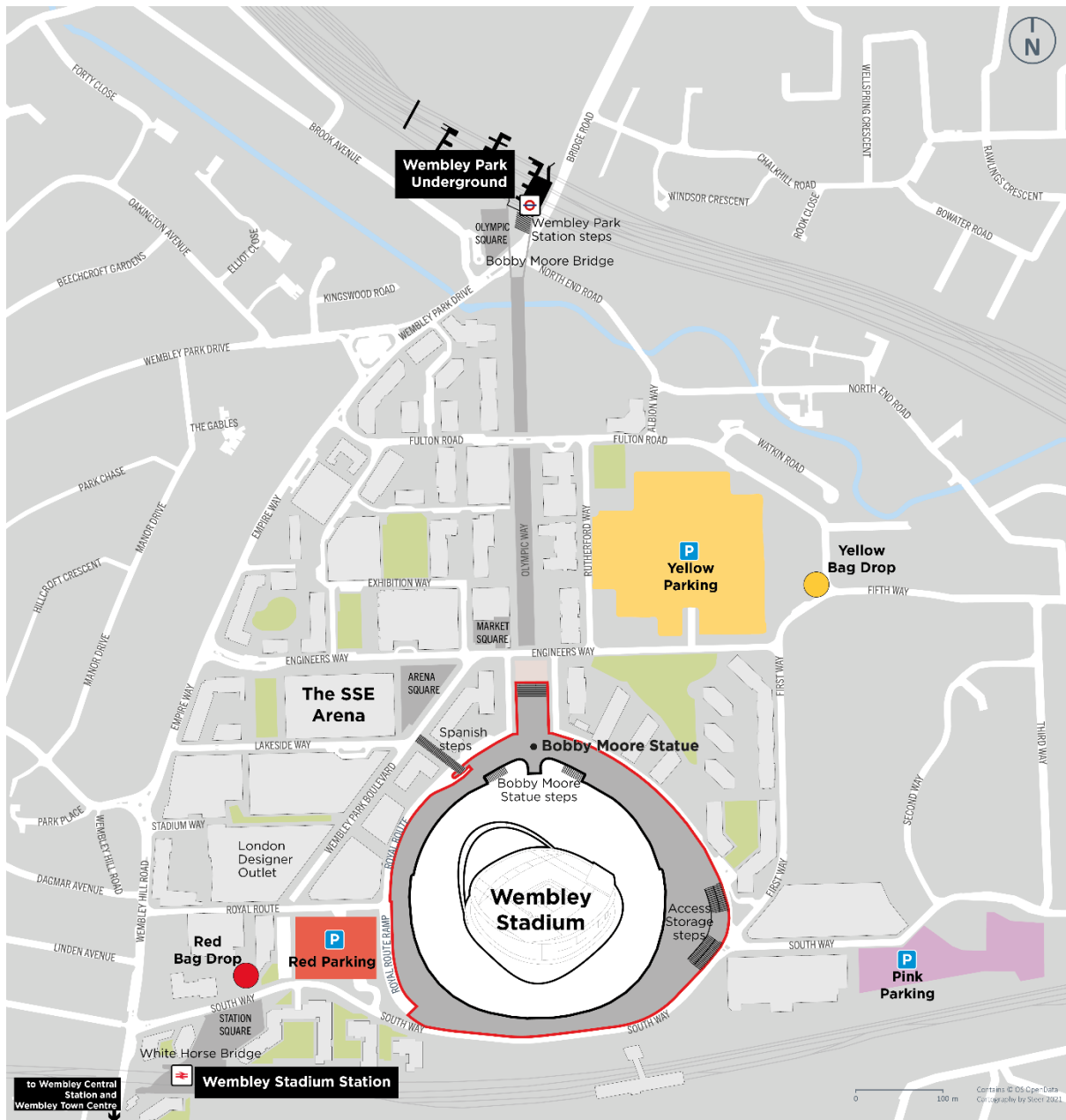
