Thank you for your recent email, which was processed under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA). You requested the following information:

Please provide the letter sent by Andy Hobart or another senior official in the MHCLG finance team to Nick Walkley, the then CEO of Homes England, raising or formalising concerns about the approval of a loan made by Homes England to the company overseeing the redevelopment of Earls Court. For clarity, the Earls Court company was acquired by Delancey in 2019.

Response

We are able to confirm that Homes England does not hold the information detailed in your request.

In order to conclude that the information is not held, we have searched with our Executive Office, Investments and Legal teams who would have the requested information if held.

You may also complain to the Information Commissioner's Office (ICO) however, the Information Commissioner does usually expect the internal review procedure to be exhausted in the first instance.
