## **Judgment on Remedy**

1 The Respondent shall pay the Claimant compensation in the sum of **£19,705.04** (nineteen thousand, seven hundred and five pounds and four pence), in respect of her well-founded claims of unfair dismissal and disability discrimination.

2 This sum comprises the following:

a)	Basic award	<b>£2,648.25</b>
b)	Pension Loss	<b>£1,500.72</b>
c)	Loss of Earnings	<b>£2,824.80</b>

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d)	Loss of Statutory Rights	<b>£350.00</b>
e)	Injury to Feelings	<b>£10,000.00</b>
f)	Interest	<b>£2,381.27</b>
