JUDGMENT

- 1. The claimant's claim of unauthorized deductions from wages relating to underpaid wages in the period up to and including 23rd November 2019 is struck out for lack of jurisdiction. The claim was presented to the Tribunal outside the statutory time limit in section 23 Employment Rights Act 1996. The Tribunal finds that it was reasonably practicable for the claimant to have complied with the time limit and declines to extend time pursuant to s23(4) of the 1996 Act.
- The claimant's claim of race discrimination in relation to unpaid £50 "stand down" fees for cancelled shifts is not struck out pursuant to rule 37(1)(a) or (b) of the Employment Tribunal Rules of Procedure 2013 but is made subject to a separate deposit order of today's date.
