THE EVENTS RESEARCH PROGRAMME DIRECTION - THE ROYAL LONDON SERIES THIRD ONE DAY INTERNATIONAL, ENGLAND VS PAKISTAN – EDGBASTON CRICKET GROUND. 13 JULY 2021

THE HEALTH PROTECTION (CORONAVIRUS, RESTRICTIONS) (STEPS) (ENGLAND) REGULATIONS 2021

The Secretary of State for Digital, Culture, Media and Sport and the Secretary of State for Health and Social Care, in exercise of the powers conferred by regulation 9 of the Health Protection (Coronavirus, Restrictions) (Steps) (England) Regulations 2021 (the 'Regulations')¹, make the following Direction for the purposes of a research programme concerned with the provision of an appropriate public health response to the incidence and spread of coronavirus in England.

Before making this Direction, the Secretaries of State have consulted with Professor Jonathan Van-Tam of the Department of Health and Social Care and had regard to any advice given by him.

- 1. This Direction applies to
 - a. the following premises
 - i. the land which is shown bounded externally by the bold red line including the area marked the "colts ground" and the area marked by the fine red line, but not including the areas marked "site works" which is shown with broken red lines attached at Annex A, comprising the Warwickshire County Cricket Club Limited, Edgbaston Stadium, Edgbaston, Birmingham, B5 7QU ('the Stadium');
 - b. the Royal London Series One Day International Cricket match held at the Stadium on 13 July 2021 ('the Match').
- 2. This Direction disapplies the following restrictions and requirements in relation to the Stadium for the purposes of the Match
 - a. In relation to the Health Protection (Coronavirus, Restrictions) (Obligations of Undertakings) (England) Regulations 2020²
 - i. regulation 1A(2) (restrictions in relation to relevant premises);
 - ii. regulation 2(1) (restrictions in relation to hospitality undertakings);
 - iii. regulation 2A(1) (requirements relating to signage and information)
 - b. In relation to the Regulations
 - i. paragraph 1, Schedule 3 (participation in gatherings indoors and outdoors);



- ii. paragraph 7, Schedule 3 (restrictions on service of food and drink for consumption on the premises).
- c. In relation to the Health Protection (Coronavirus, Wearing of Face Coverings in a Relevant Place) (England) Regulations 2020³
 - i. regulation 3(1) (requirement to wear a face covering whilst entering or remaining within a relevant place).
