# JUDGMENT

- 1. Claim number 2602931/2020 is dismissed upon withdrawal.
- 2. As to claim number 2602932/2020, the claim of discrimination by reason of race is dismissed upon withdrawal.
- 3. Likewise, the claim based upon discrimination because of a religious or philosophical belief is dismissed upon withdrawal.
- 4. The Respondents having conceded that the Claimant is a disabled person, the claim based upon disability discrimination proceeds.
- 5. Having heard the submissions of Mr Rahman and his application not being opposed by Mrs Smith, the claim of constructive unfair dismissal pursuant to section 95 of the Employment Rights Act 1996 also continues.
