ABOUT THIS SURVEY

What is this survey about?

The RAF Families Survey provides spouses/civil partners with an opportunity to share their views on what life is like being married to/in a civil partnership with a member of the RAF. The survey asks questions about key welfare areas including family life, childcare, deployment, education, employment, healthcare, and housing.

Why have I received this survey?

The RAF Families Survey is sent to a random selection of Service families each year, located both within the UK and overseas. Since the Data Protection Act (2018) does not allow us to contact families directly, the Service personnel to whom the survey is addressed to is requested to pass this survey to their spouse/civil partner for completion.

How are the findings used?

The results from the survey are used to aid the development and monitoring of military personnel policies and welfare initiatives. They are also used to inform and monitor Defence personnel programmes and the Armed Forces Covenant.

I am also serving. Do I still need to complete it?

We are interested in capturing the views of both civilian partners and dual-serving couples as they both face unique issues. If you and your spouse/civil partner are both serving in the Armed Forces, this survey should be completed by the spouse/civil partner of the named recipient of the survey.

Do I have to complete the survey?

Whilst completion is entirely voluntary, we encourage recipients to tell us their views so that we can make positive changes in the RAF.

Who will see my answers?

All replies will be treated in the strictest confidence and are completely anonymous. Your individual responses will only be seen by the civilian researchers conducting this survey and external data input contractors. 2020 FamCAS HEADLINE REPORT SUMMARY OF KEY FINDINGS

- **Response rates.** 8,852 Regular Army Service Personnel (SP) were sent the Families Continuous Attitude Survey (FamCAS) to pass onto their spouses. A total of 2,466 useable surveys were returned, providing a response rate of 28%, up 1% from last year.
- About you. The majority of respondents are female (93%), 80% have children, and just under half of spouses are below the age of 35. Spouses of ORs tend to be younger than those of Officers. Eight percent of families are 'dual serving' with the majority of spouses (83%) having 'never served in the Armed Forces'. Most spouses are located in England (63%), and of those who responded from England were mainly based in the South.
- Accommodation. Half of families (51%) 'own their own home', with more families of Officers (79%) owning their own home than ORs (43%). Property ownership has increased 8% since 2011, however, since 2016 it has remained relatively stable. Families decided to buy property mainly for 'stability of themselves and their family' (70%), for 'financial investment' (31%), and 'due to the poor standard of SFA' (18%).
- The main reason why families don't own property, is because they 'cannot afford to buy a suitable home at the moment' (54%). Secondly, 40% feel 'living in Service accommodation suited their family's needs at the present time'. However, from the 69% of families who 'live in SFA during the working week', only 58% are satisfied with the overall standard. Families are more dissatisfied than satisfied with the 'response to maintenance/repair requests' and 'quality of maintenance/repair work'. Sixty-eight percent of families feel that SFA is good 'value for money'.
- Spousal employment. Seventy-seven percent of spouses are currently employed. Since 2014 there has been a larger increase in 'spousal employment' of ORs spouses' (18%) compared to spouses of Officers (10%). Although 6% more spouses are in full-time employment (47%) than in 2018, 43% of spouses have had to 'look for employment over the last 12 months'. The main difficulties spouses face when gaining employment were mainly due to their 'partner not being able to assist with 'care responsibilities' (48%), 'having a spouse who is often away' (46%), and 'extended family living too far away to assist with childcare' (46%).
- Over half (56%) of spouses reported that 'Service life has had a negative effect on their career progression', with the main reasons being 'frequent moves with Service positing's' (63%), a 'partner that is unable to assist with care responsibilities' (57%), and the 'location of Service postings' (51%).
- **Childcare.** Eighty percent of families have children. Just over a third of families of early years children (0-4 years) and just under half of families of school aged children have needed childcare during the last 12 months.
- Most spouses are satisfied with the 'quality' of childcare for local early years childcare facilities (83%), and childcare for 'school aged children' (68%). However, they are least satisfied with the 'cost' of early years and school aged childcare.

- Two-thirds of families don't access any free form of informal childcare, and a third of families only use formal childcare. Significantly more spouses of ORs (33%) require formal childcare, than spouses of Officers (24%). However, 59% of ORs' spouses, and 43% of Officers' spouses 'don't take up the offer of any Government initiatives around childcare'. Of the half of families who 'don't use Government childcare initiatives', 17% 'think they are not eligible'.
- **Children's education.** Over half (56%) of families with children have a 'child of school age', with the majority attending 'state' schools (79%). There are disparities between the types of school's children of Officers and ORs attend. Significantly more children of ORs attend a 'state school' (ORs=83%, Officers=64%) whereas significantly more children of Officers attend an independent day (Officers=11%, ORs=4%), or 'boarding school' (Officers=26%, ORs=8%).
- Furthermore, more families of Officers utilise CEA and believe it is an important part of the Army package, than families of ORs. Just over half (51%) of families of ORs were unsure whether CEA was an important aspect of the Army package.
- Armed Forces Covenant (AFC). Just over a third of spouses (36%) have not 'heard of the AFC', and of those who are aware of the AFC, 18% 'know nothing about it'. Furthermore, 66% of spouses were not aware of the 'Armed Forces X-Factor', and of those who had, 10% knew nothing about it. With 32% of those who knew about it agreeing it was 'enough to compensate for Service life'.
- Compared to the general public, spouses felt more disadvantaged when it came to 'family life', and 75% of spouses agreed that 'opportunities for flexible working' would have a positive impact on 'family life'.
- Sixty-one percent of spouses feel satisfied with the 'quality of life being married to a member of the Army', with 82% of spouses 'proud of their spouse being in the Army'. The 'annual leave entitlement' (64%) and 'job security' (63%) are also positive factors of Service life. The most negative aspects are the effect of Service family life on 'their career' (58%), and the 'separation from their Serving spouse' (48%). Fifty-three percent of spouses don't 'feel valued by the Army', and more spouses 'feel part of the civilian community' (47%) than the 'wider Army community' (28%). Incidentally, 14% of spouses have 'encouraged their serving spouse to leave the Army', and 27% would be 'happier if they were to leave'.
- Wellbeing. There has been a significant increase in high 'anxiety' levels in spouses of ORs from 27% last year to 34%, with no change in spouses of Officers. There are also significantly more spouses of Officers (40%) reporting a high level of 'feeling that things in their life are worthwhile' compared to spouses of ORs (33%). More spouses of ORs (18%) often/always feel lonely, compared to spouses of Officers (13%).
