#### Auditor's report

#### Independent Auditors' Report to the Members of the Warwick International Staff Association

We have audited the financial statements of the Warwick International Staff Association for the period ended 31st December 2020 which comprise the income and expenditure account and the balance sheet. The financial reporting framework that has been applied in their preparation is applicable law and United Kingdom Accounting Standards (United Kingdom Generally Accepted Accounting Practice).

#### Opinion on financial statements
