JUDGMENT

The claimant's application for reconsideration of the judgment sent to the parties on 11 May 2021 is granted.

The Judgment is revoked, exercising powers pursuant to Regulations 70-72 Schedule 1 Employment Tribunals (C&RP) Regulations 2013 and does not take effect.

REASONS

1. The claimant brought a claim for unfair dismissal and unlawful deduction from pay on 25th February 2021.
2. It was unclear from the claim form whether she had sufficient service for her unfair dismissal claim and the Tribunal wrote to her on 4th March 2021 asking her to clarify the position by 18th March 2021.
3. The claimant did so by letter of 9th March 2021, providing details of her start date and supporting evidence, from which it appears that she was continuously employed for over 2 years. Unfortunately, that letter was not attached to the case file or brought to my attention.
4. I issued judgment on 6th May 2021 striking out the claim of unfair dismissal.
5. By email of 11th May 2021, the claimant sought reconsideration of my judgment, pointing out that she had provided the requested details.
6. In these circumstances it is clearly in the interests of justice for me to revoke my judgment and allow the claim of unfair dismissal to proceed.
7. I have listed the case for hearing and given directions which will be sent to the parties separately.
