- records will be supplied to RPA in the timescales explained in section H of the ON 26 Scheme Guidance. Fines and suspension of approval can be incurred where this obligation is not met

You must inform the Agency immediately of any changes which may affect your approval status.

Approval can be withdrawn if you do not comply with the requirements of the scheme.
