

## **9002NFG - EXPORT of laboratory porcine samples to Germany**

### **NOTES FOR GUIDANCE (NFG) FOR OFFICIAL VETERINARIANS AND EXPORTERS**

This document should not be read as a standalone document but in conjunction with 9002EHC.

#### **1. SCOPE OF THE CERTIFICATE**

This certificate may be used for the export of samples from porcine animals resident at research establishments under veterinary supervision where the certification takes place in Wales, Scotland or England, i.e. Great Britain only.

#### **2. CERTIFICATION**

The basic principles of certification apply and although this is not an EU level harmonised EU entry certificate, the general requirements that the EU specifies for its harmonised certificates should be followed.

**EXPORTING COUNTRY:** Although the certificate has been prepopulated with UNITED KINGDOM, this certificate should and can only be issued for animals that are certified in England, Scotland and Wales (i.e. Great Britain).

##### **I. Origin**

Please include both the name and address of the sender and the establishment of origin if they are not the same.

##### **II. Destination**

Self-explanatory

##### **III. Identification**

This certificate may be used for more than one or batch of samples sample at a time. Should the space provided not be enough create and include a schedule to add additional information or replace the section on batch numbers and ID of the samples.

Please include the numbers of samples and their identification numbers as well as the genus and species name of the animals from which the samples originate.

##### **IV. Health Attestation**

Self-explanatory
