Thank you for your correspondence dated 7 July 2021 received under the terms of the Freedom of Information Act 2000. The specific details of your request have been extracted from your email and are highlighted in bold within the body of this letter.

How much income has been generated in the last 12 months from dart charge accounts that have been closed due to inactivity, which still have funds at the time of closure and refunds are not claimed.

£1.984m has been claimed by Dart Charge between July 2020 and June 2021 for accounts closed due to inactivity.
