Thank you for your recent email, which was processed under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA). You requested the following information:

Please disclose all internal correspondence concerning the decision to rename the Homes England Twitter account "It's coming Homes England".

Response

We can confirm that we do hold the requested information. Please find enclosed Annex A which contains the internal correspondence that falls within the scope of your request.

Section 40 – Personal information

We have redacted information contained within Annex A on the grounds that in constitutes third party personal data and therefore engages section 40(2) of the FOIA.

To disclose personal data, such as names, contact details, and email addresses could lead to the identification of third parties and would breach one or more of the data protection principles.

Section 40 is an absolute exemption which means that we do not need to consider the public interest in disclosure. Once it is established that the information is personal data of a third party and release would breach one or more of the data protection principles, then the exemption is engaged.
