What was the membership fee given to Stonewall as part of their Diversity Champions programme in each of 2018-19, 2019-20 and 2020-21 by your organisation?

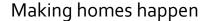
We can confirm that the annual membership fee paid to Stonewall for the Diversity Champions programme was £2500 plus VAT for each year.
