## **RULE 21 LIABILITY AND REMEDY JUDGMENT**

## The judgment of the Tribunal is as follows:

- Pursuant to Rule 21 on the Respondent having failed to enter a response within the required time limit and the response received out of time with no details and no application to extend time, the claim succeeds.
- 2. The claim before the tribunal to which the rule 21 liability judgment relates, is a claim for breach of contract, unlawful deductions from pay and holiday pay.
- 3. The Claimant has provided a detailed breakdown of the sums claimed.
- 4. The tribunal declares that the claimant is entitled to receive the total sum of £9,588.23 calculated as follows:
  - a. his unpaid salary between January 2020 and January 2021 amounting to £1.226.84 (net);
  - b. his contracted car allowance for 14 months amounting to £5,600 (gross);
  - c. his pension contributions for the period 2 July 2019 to 5 February 2021 amounting to £1,194.15 (gross); and
  - d. unpaid 16.3 days' accrued leave amounting to £1567.24 (net).
- 5. The recoupment provisions do not apply
