JUDGMENT

- 1. The claimant's complaint of unfair dismissal succeeds. The respondent is ordered to pay the claimant the following sums:
 - a. Basic award of £3,228
 - b. Compensatory award of £21,000
- 2. The claimant's complaint of unlawful deduction from wages succeeds. The respondent is ordered to pay the claimant the sum of £17,500.

- 2. The parties were able to hear what the tribunal heard and see the witnesses as seen by the tribunal. From a technical perspective, there were no difficulties.
- 3. The participants were told that it was an offence to record the proceedings.
- 4. Evidence was heard from the claimant and from Mr Mackay.
- 5. I was satisfied that none of the witnesses was being coached or assisted by any unseen third party while giving their evidence.
