JUDGMENT

1. The proceedings on the complaints contained within the claim were not brought before the end of 3 months starting with the date of the acts to which the claim relates in accordance with section 123(1)(a) of the Equality Act 2010.

3. The claim shall now proceed to the final hearing listed on 25-29 July 2022 and in accordance with the case summary, case management orders, and list of complaints and issues settled at the case management hearing on 10 February 2021.

4. The Tribunal notes that the claimant's status as a disabled person for the purposes of his claim is now conceded.
