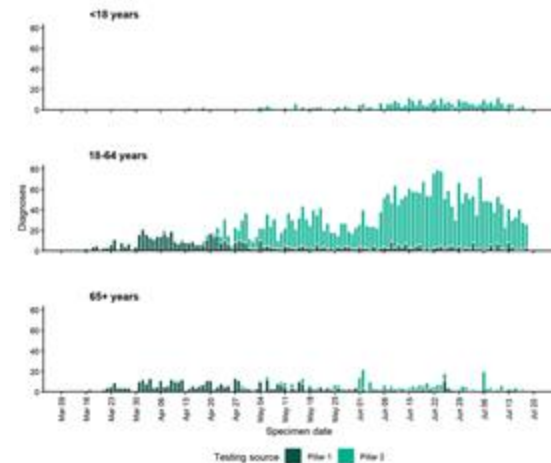
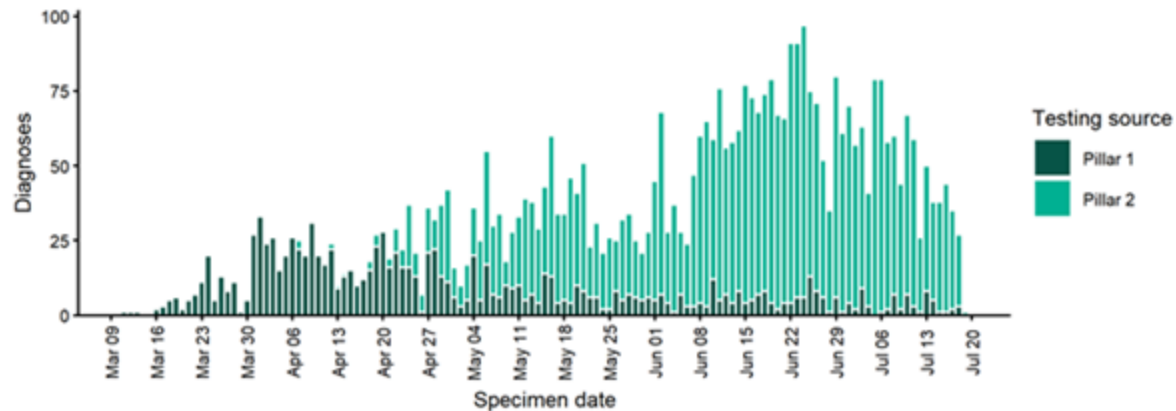

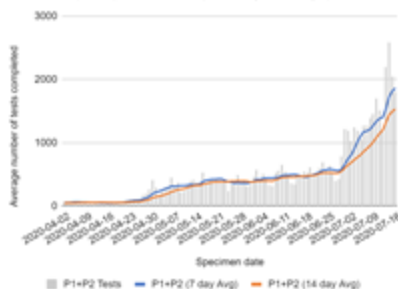
Epidemic curve of daily confirmed COVID-19 cases by specimen date: 11 March - 19 July 2020



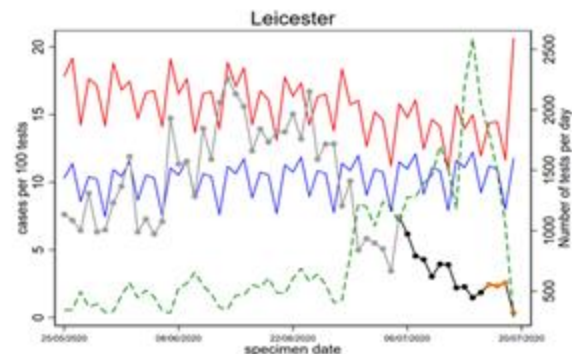
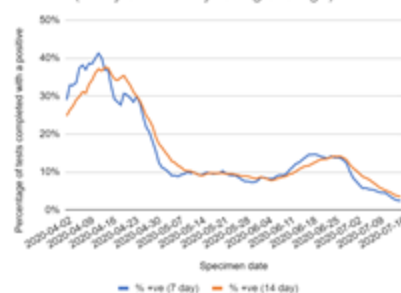
Daily average number of positive tests (7-day and 14-day rolling average)



Number of individuals tested daily (7-day and 14-day rolling average)



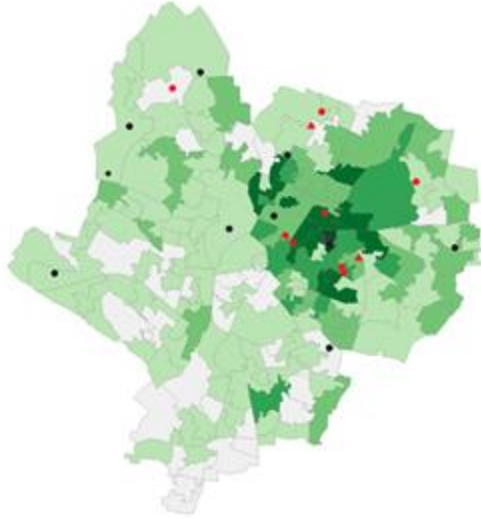
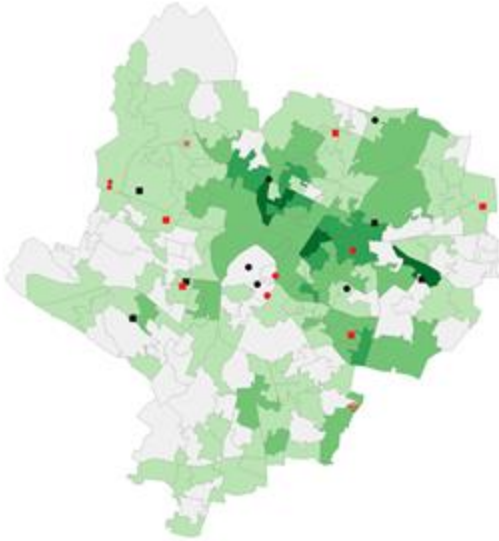
Percentage of individuals testing positive (7-day and 14-day rolling average)

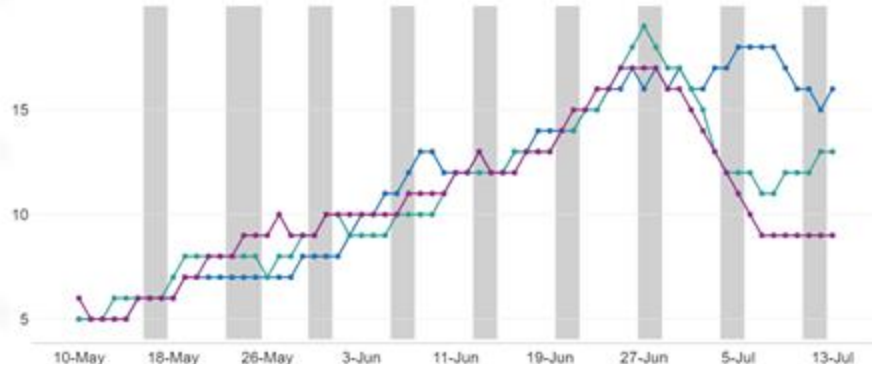

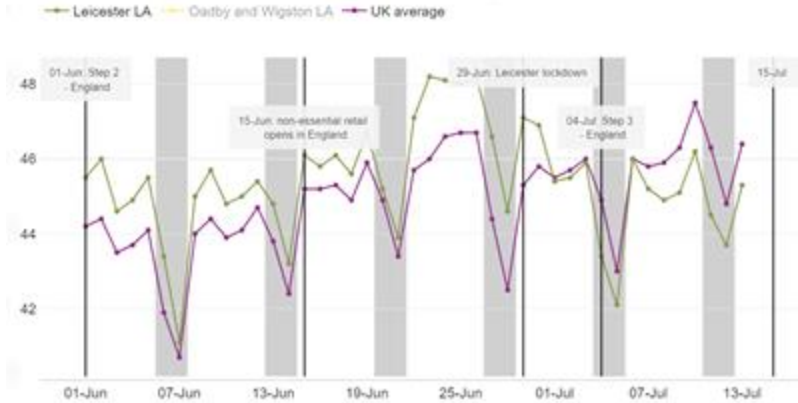
**Mobility in Leicester down sharply. Some evidence of people leaving the city over past week**

**Rail journeys to Leicester have fallen sharply, but those from Leicester have recovered recently**

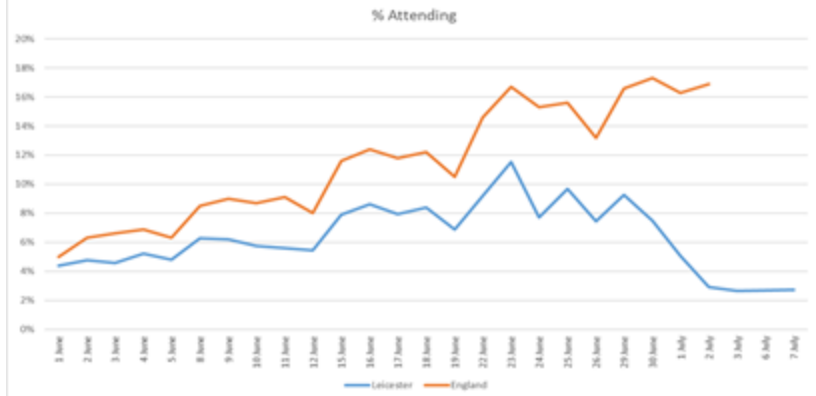
— Journeys with Leicester Destination — Journeys with Leicester Origin
