## **JUDGMENT**

The former Second Respondent's application dated 18 June 2021 for reconsideration of the Judgment sent to the parties on 7 June 2021 (the "Judgment") is refused.

## **REASONS**

- 1. There is no reasonable prospect of the original decision being varied or revoked, because the matters the former Second Respondent raises in her application for reconsideration have been duly considered by the Tribunal in making the Judgment.
- 2. The application does not disclose any new facts or circumstances, which would justify revisiting the original decision.
- 3. The former Second Respondent appears to be attempting to re-argue her original costs application after it has been decided. In the reconsideration application she further develops arguments she ran in her original costs' application. There are no apparent reasons why such further developed arguments could not have been included in the original costs' application. In any event, they are not sufficient to outweigh the importance of maintaining finality of litigation.
- 4. Therefore, the tribunal does not consider that it is necessary in the interest of justice to reconsider the Judgment.
