JUDGMENT

- 1. There was a relevant transfer from the First Respondent to the Second respondent.
- The Claimant was automatically unfairly dismissed pursuant to Regulation 7 of the Transfer of Undertakings (Protection of Employment) Regulations 2006 "TUPE".
- 3. The Claimant failed to inform and consult with the Claimant contrary to Regulation 13 of TUPE. The Claimant is awarded the sum of **£6240**
- The Claimant was unfairly dismissed contrary to section 99 of the Employment Rights 1996. The Claimant is award a basic award of £480.76.
- 5. The Claimant is awarded a compensatory award for unfair dismissal of **£16,970.32.**
- The Claimant was discriminated against contrary to Section 18 of the Equality Act 2010. The Claimant is awarded the sum of £12,500 for injury to feelings.
- The Claimant was due statutory maternity pay on the termination of her employment. The Respondent is to pay to the Claimant the sum of £3524.50 of statutory maternity pay due and owing.

- The Claimant was owed holiday pay accrued but untaken at the date of termination. The Respondent is to pay to the Claimant holiday pay of £1475.60
- The liability for the sums due and owing transfer from the First Respondent to the Second Respondent pursuant to Regulation 4 of TUPE.

This is not subject to recoupment
