JUDGMENT

- The complaint of unfair dismissal is well-founded and succeeds. 1.
- The breach of contract claim succeeds. The Claimant was entitled to receive 2. 2 weeks' notice of dismissal.
- 3. The unpaid annual leave claim is successful. The Claimant is entitled to a payment of 0.22 weeks' pay in lieu.
- The Respondent made unauthorised deductions from wages. 4.
- The Respondent failed to comply with the obligation in section 1 the 5. Employment Rights Act 1996.
- The Claimant meets the definition of disabled person in accordance with s6 6. Equality Act 2010. However, the complaints of disability discrimination (direct, discrimination arising from disability, failure to make reasonable adjustments) and harassment fail and are dismissed.
- There will be a one day remedy hearing by video on a date to be notified. 7.
