### JUDGMENT

#### Rule 37 of Schedule 1 to the Employment Tribunals (Constitution and Rules of Procedure) Regulations 2013

1. The claim is dismissed.

### REASONS

1. On 12 June 2021 the Tribunal wrote to the Claimant to inform him that an Employment Judge was considering striking out the claim because the claim has not been actively pursued.
2. The Claimant was given until 25 June 2021 to object to this proposal and give reasons in writing or request a hearing at which he could make them.
3. The Claimant has not responded to the Tribunal's letter.
4. The claim is therefore dismissed because the claim has not been actively pursued.
