## **JUDGMENT**

- (1) The name of the Respondent is amended to Young Individuals Count Ltd.
- (2) The Claimant's claim that the Respondent had made an unlawful deduction from her wages pursuant to section 13(1) of the Employment Rights Act is well founded. This means that her claim succeeds.
- (3) The Respondent is ordered to pay to the Claimant the **sum of £2,210.88** (**gross**) calculated as follows:

For work undertaken in Dec 2018/Jan 2019:

130.55 hours at £8.00/hr = £1,044.40

8 sleep over rates at £40.00 each = £320.00

For work undertaken in Jan/Feb 2019:

80.81 hours at £8.00/hr = £646.48

5 sleep over rates at £40.00 each = £200.00
