## JUDGMENT

- 1. The Claimant's claim of unlawful deduction from wages succeeds, in that he has been underpaid by 25 pence per hour since February 2021 and there is therefore a shortfall (adjusted to account for him being on furlough, by agreement) of £177.36.
- 2. The Claimant has incurred financial loss as a result of his underpayments and late payments, in the sum of £232.32.
- 3. Accordingly, the Respondent is ordered to pay the Claimant the sum of £409.68.
