I, the undersigned Official Veterinarian, hereby certify that:

- a) the animal(s)* for export is/are* healthy and free from clinical signs of communicable diseases and fit for transport.
- b) the animal(s)* for export originate(s)* from a government registered or licensed zoological gardens, wildlife park, scientific or other institution approved for the holding of primates;
- c) the animal(s)* for export originate(s)* from a premises that is under permanent veterinary supervision, and where a suitable health-monitoring programme of the animal(s) is/are followed, so that incursions of disease are identified, and control and/or eradication measures can be applied.
