1. The claimant's claim that he was unfairly dismissed is successful. The respondent is ordered to pay the claimant the following sums:

a.	Compensation for 4 weeks' loss of earnings	£1520
b.	Loss of statutory rights	£400
C	Total	£1920

- 2. The claimant's claim for a redundancy payment is successful and the respondent is ordered to pay the claimant a redundancy payment of £2400.
- 3. The claimant's claim for breach of contract for failure to pay notice pay is successful. The respondent is ordered to pay the claimant the gross sum of £1920 (subject to deductions for tax and national insurance).

Recoupment

- 4. For the purposes of regulation 4(3) of The Employment Protection (Recoupment of Jobseeker's Allowance and Income Support) Regulations 1996 (which apply to this judgment)
 - a. The monetary award is £6240
 - b. The amount of the prescribed element is £1520
 - c. The dates of the period to which the prescribed element is attributable are 14 March 2020 10 April 2020
