III. Veterinary Scrapie and Tuberculosis Declaration

- i) On the basis of official records, I certify that scrapie has not been confirmed on the holdings referred to in section II, during their period of residency in the holdings in question and in the last seven years;
- ii) The dam and sire of the donor identified in paragraph I has not been confirmed to have been affected by any Spongiform Encephalopathy;
- iii) On the basis of official records, I certify that tuberculosis has not been confirmed in the holdings referred to in section II where the donor animal was resident in during the six (6) months prior to the collection of the semen/embryos for export;
- *iv) The donors have remained for at least thirty (30) days prior to and after embryo collection at an establishment that is not located in restriction zones for notifiable sheep diseases for which disease transmission may occur through embryos. This includes Foot and Mouth Disease, Brucellosis, Bluetongue, Contagious Caprine Pleuropneumonia, Rinderpest, Peste des Petits Ruminants, Sheep and Goat Pox and Rift Valley Fever.
