

## **EXPORT OF CANINE SEMEN TO FRANCE**

### **NOTES FOR GUIDANCE (NFG) FOR OFFICIAL VETERINARIANS AND EXPORTERS**

This document should not be read as a standalone document but in conjunction with 9016EHC.

Please note that this certificate is taken from an English translation provided by France and the English text is therefore constrained by that model certificate.

#### **SCOPE OF THE CERTIFICATE**

This certificate may be used for the export of canine semen where the certification takes place in Wales, Scotland or England, i.e. Great Britain only

#### **1. IDENTIFICATION OF THE PRODUCTS**

For 'race' please read 'breed' and enter accordingly. The 'country of origin' and 'country imported from' is both 'GB' if semen was collected in Great Britain. Preservation method: please specify chilled or frozen and add particulars as appropriate.

For quantity please specify number of straws or such other measure as is appropriate to the preservation of the commodity.

#### **2. ORIGIN AND DESTINATION**

Premises of first destination is the first premises in France that will take reception of the commodity after crossing the border into the EU. For transits of French territory, please enter the address and country of destination.

#### **3. HEALTH INFORMATION AND CERTIFICATION**

The basic principles of certification apply and although this is not a harmonised EU level entry certificate, the general requirements that the EU specifies for its harmonised certificates should be followed.

#### **4. DISCLAIMER**

This certificate is provided on the basis of information available at the time and may not necessarily comply fully with the requirements of the importing country. It is the exporter's responsibility to check the certificate against any relevant import permit or any advice provided by the competent authority in the importing country. If these do not match,
