I, the undersigned, certify that the poultry described at Section I above meet the following requirements:

- a) During the 90 days prior to export, the poultry to be exported, and their flocks of origin:
 - (i) Were not exposed to highly pathogenic avian influenza (HPAI) or Newcastle disease (avian paramyxovirus-1);
 - (ii) Were not in any country, region or zone established because of the detection of Newcastle disease or HPAI in commercial poultry;
 - (iii) Were inspected on the premises of origin prior to movement for export and were found to be clinically free of signs of communicable diseases of poultry;
 - (iv) During the 90 days prior to export, the flock of origin of the poultry to be exported had no contact with:
 - a. poultry or other avians of a lesser health status than the requirements specified in this certificate;
 - b. wild birds;
- b) The consignment did not originate from, or (based on the route plan and declaration provided by the exporter) travel through, any zones within the APHIS-defined European Poultry Trade Region⁽²⁾ that were restricted for outbreaks of Newcastle disease or HPAI in commercial poultry for the following period of time, whichever is later:

1)* until the restrictions were lifted by the national competent authority; or

2)* 90 days after depopulation of all affected premises, followed by cleaning and disinfection of the last affected premises, in that zone.

[Note: only 1) applies if the restrictions had been placed for Newcastle disease or HPAI in racing pigeons, backyard flocks or wild birds.]
