IV. Health Information

I, the undersigned, being an Official Veterinarian, hereby certify that:

- (a) the animal/s for export was/were born and reared in zoological premises which are under veterinary supervision;
- (b) the animal/s to be exported was/were* isolated for a period of 30 days prior to dispatch in an authorised and officially controlled quarantine; within this period no other animal/s* was/were* introduced to this group;
- (c) there has been no clinical or other evidence in the animals for export of infection with **Herpes B virus, simian immunodeficiency virus, hepatitis A virus and hepatitis B virus**;
- (d) there has been no evidence of **zoonotic** infections (transmissible to man) in the primate enclosure during the past 24 months;
- (e) there has been no evidence of major zoonotic infections (transmissible to man), **including Anthrax, Bovine Spongiform Encephalopathy, Brucellosis (Brucella melitensis) Crimean-Congo haemorrhagic fever, Ebola virus, Highly Pathogenic Avian Influenza, Japanese encephalomyelitis virus, Marburg haemorrhagic fever, New-world screwworm, Q fever, Rabies, Rift valley fever, Sheep pox / Goat pox, Tularaemia, Venezuelan equine encephalomyelitis or West Nile virus** in the premises of origin during the past 24 months;
- (f) the animal/s originate from premises where there has been no case of tuberculosis in the building or enclosure in which the animals reside for the past 2 years prior to export;
- (g) on (date) and, being within 30 days prior to export the animal/s was/were tested for tuberculosis with negative results;
- (h) in the case of Macaca the animal/s to be exported was/were tested for Herpes B within 30 days of dispatch on and (dates) with negative results;
- (i) in the case of Macaca or African monkeys the animal/s to be exported was/were tested for SIV within 30 days of dispatch on and (dates) with negative results;

(j) on and (dates), being within 30 days prior to export and with an interval of not less than 14 days, the animals for export were submitted to two treatments for endoparasites (round tapeworms) and ectoparasites:

(k) within the 14 days prior to despatch the animal/s to be exported was/were* examined at least twice weekly by a veterinarian and no signs or symptoms of infectious and contagious diseases were detected;

(l) I have received a declaration from the owner/exporter stating that the animal/s for export has/have* never been used in experimental work involving infectious materials;

(m) on (date), within 48 hours prior to despatch, I examined the animal(s)* for export under clear daylight conditions and found it/them to be healthy and free from any symptoms of infectious or contagious disease, and in my opinion fit to travel;

(n) I have received a written declaration from the owner/exporter that the animals will be caged and transported in accordance with International Air Transport Association (IATA) Regulations;

(o) the animals described above have been treated before and at the time of loading in accordance with the relevant provisions of the O.I.E. Terrestrial Animal Health Code chapters 7.1-7.4 (animal welfare).
