JUDGMENT

The Claimant's claim for deductions from wages/unpaid wages is struck out under Rule 37 of the Employment Tribunal's Rules of Procedure 2013.

REASONS

- 1. The Claimant's claims for unpaid wages relates to statutory sick pay.
- 2. Upon discussion, it was clear that there is a dispute between the parties as to the Claimant's entitlement to the statutory sick pay claimed. In <u>Taylor Gordon and Co Limited (t/a Plan Personnel) v Timmons</u> 2004 IRLR 180, it was held that Employment Tribunal's have no jurisdiction to consider a claim regarding entitlements to statutory sick pay.
