JUDGMENT

- 1. The claimant's complaints of:
 - 1.1 unauthorised deductions from wages (under s13 of the Employment Rights Act 1996);
 - 1.2 under-payment of holiday pay (under s13 of the Employment Rights Act 1996 and under the Working Time Regulations 1998);
 - 1.3 wrongful dismissal (notice pay) (under the Employment Tribunals Extension of Jurisdiction (England and Wales) Order 1994); and
 - 1.4 failure to provide a written statement of particulars (under s38 of the Employment Act 2002);

succeed and are upheld.

2. The claimant is awarded the amounts set out in the table below. The claimant is responsible for any PAYE deductions due on the awards made.
