

## Application for an Optional Indication Certificate for Poultrymeat Being Exported to the EU or Moved to Northern Ireland

Poultrymeat exports from England and Wales bearing one or more farming or chilling method marks (Optional Indications) must be accompanied by an additional Optional Indications Certificate. More information on poultrymeat optional indications is available on GOV.UK.

Please note, this application is for Optional Indications Certificates where the poultrymeat was raised, processed and will be exported from England and Wales only.

If you need to apply for an Optional Indications Certificate for poultrymeat that was raised, processed and the export is from Scotland you should contact: LivestockPolicy@gov.scot.

Applications should be submitted at least five working days in advance of your intended export date and will be processed during office working hours Monday to Friday 08.30 to 17.00, excluding public holidays.

Applications must be completed in full. Incomplete applications will be returned which may result in a delay to your export.

You must attach the processor (slaughterhouse) weight ticket(s) with this application and feed ingredients for any poultry feed ration.

A separate application must be submitted for each export consignment you require an Optional Indications Certificate for.
