3. the product contains processed animal proteins which were produced in a plant/facility approved in accordance with European Council Directive 90/667/EEC<sup>(1)</sup>.
4. in accordance with Council Decision 2000/766/EC, the product cannot be fed to farmed animals which are kept, fattened or bred for the production of food;
