Dear Jane

I was asked by [REDACTED] to have a look at her letter to a patient reporting finasteride syndrome, depression and suicidal ideation. Looking at the case folder I realised that we had received FU from the GP informing us that the patient had, in fact, taken his own life, which was a shock.

I would like to follow up again with the GP to see if the patient's reported low testosterone was documented; whether in the opinion of the doctor there was anything confounding the case, such as medical history, social circumstance or concomitant pathology. We could ask for the post mortem report. What do you think? It would need to be handled sensitively but further follow up with a HCP would be useful.
