Respondent: Mitchell Phillips Barbers Ltd

Introduction

The proceedings were received by the respondent. There has been no response form filed. The Tribunal has been told the company has ceased trading and an application has been made to dissolve it. The claimant is entitled to notice of that application and to object. If the company is/was insolvent the sums owing may be payable from the National Insurance Fund. In the meantime there is sufficient information on the file for me to give Judgment.

RULE 21 JUDGMENT

The claimant's complaints of unlawful deductions from wages and breach of contract and unpaid holiday pay succeed and the respondent shall pay to him the gross sums of:

Notice pay: £ 193.50
Unpaid wages: £336.00
Holiday pay: £910.57.

It is for the claimant to account for any tax and employee national insurance on the sums above.
