# **JUDGMENT**

The unanimous judgment of the Tribunal is as follows:

- 1. The claimant's claims of unfair dismissal are dismissed, the claimant having been found not to have the status of employee as required to claim unfair dismissal.
- 2. The claimant's claims that he was subjected to detriments in response to a qualifying protected disclosure are dismissed, the alleged disclosure being found not to amount to a qualifying protected disclosure and the alleged detriments having been found to have no connection to the alleged disclosure.
- 3. The claimant's claim for holiday pay is dismissed, the claimant having been found to have been paid for all holiday accrued.

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4. The claimant's claim for notice pay is dismissed because the evidence did not support the claimant's contention that he was entitled to further notice pay.
