## JUDGMENT

1. The claimant was an employee of the respondent.
2. The claimant's claim of unauthorised deduction of wages is well-founded and succeeds. The respondent shall pay the claimant **£2,250.00** under this head of claim.
3. The claimant's claim of failure to pay holiday pay for the period 25 June 2020 to 25 December 2020 is well-founded and succeeds. The respondent shall pay the claimant **£1,459.04** under this head of claim.
4. The claimant's claim of breach of contract (failure to reimburse the claimant for expenses) is well-founded and succeeds. The respondent shall pay the claimant **£366.01** under this head of claim.
5. The total payable by the respondent to the claimant is **£4,074.05**.

Note: This has been a remote hearing. The parties did not object to the case being heard remotely. It was not practicable to hold a face to face hearing because of the Covid19 pandemic.
