- 1. The claimant was an employee of the respondent.
- 2. The claimant's claim of unauthorised deduction of wages is well-founded and succeeds. The respondent shall pay the claimant £2,250.00 under this head of claim.
- 3. The claimant's claim of failure to pay holiday pay for the period 25 June 2020 to 25 December 2020 is well-founded and succeeds. The respondent shall pay the claimant £1,459.04 under this head of claim.
- 4. The claimant's claim of breach of contract (failure to reimburse the claimant for expenses) is well-founded and succeeds. The respondent shall pay the claimant £366.01 under this head of claim.
- 5. The total payable by the respondent to the claimant is £4,074.05.
