## JUDGMENT

- 1. The claims of unfair dismissal, unauthorised deductions from wages and breach of contract were not presented within the statutory time limit despite it being reasonably practicable to do so and are each dismissed.
- 2. The disability discrimination, harassment and victimisation claims were not presented within the statutory three month period of 3 months from the last act complained of but it is just and equitable to permit them to proceed.
- 3. The Tribunal at final hearing remain at liberty to determine whether acts / omissions prior to the last act complained of form part of conduct extending over a period and/or are out of time and/or whether it is just and equitable to extend time in respect of some or all of those acts / omissions.
